The Council website will be updated by 1 January 2021 to show this information.



Stay safe over Easter

COVID-19 infection rates are still high in Hounslow, so it's really important families get tested twice a week to help stop the spread of infection. Rapid testing is available for those who **do not**have COVID-19 symptoms.

If you're a parent/guardian or in a childcare/support bubble with nursery school, primary school, secondary school and college aged children, you can collect a FREE pack of Rapid Tests.

Choose your nearest collection site <u>click here</u>. No need to book. You must be over 18 years old and NOT have COVID-19 symptoms to collect your pack.

Other ways to get your family tested:

- You can access Rapid Tests via your employer if they are offering testing to employees
- If you unable to get test kit from your employer or a collection site, you can order a home test kit online: <u>Order rapid lateral flow home test kits</u>


