	Rich Victorian children played with toys such as clockwork trains, rocking horses, tea sets and dolls. Poorer children played with homemade toys such as peg dolls, wooden boats and rags stuffed with sawdust to make balls or toy animals.					
	Not many people could read or write but Queen Victoria made all children go to school.					
	Grove Road Primary school was built in the Victorian times. The front of the school is part of the original building. The part where your classroom is was added later.					
Science	Materials used for clothes: Leather—used for shoes, jackets and trousers Wool—used for jumpers, socks, pyjamas and coats Cotton—used for clothes we wear on warmer days and shirts Silk—expensive materials used for scarves and blouses. Glass is used for windows in houses and cars to see through and mirrors to see yourself and your reflection.					
	Metal is used for strength –in construction of planes, cars and trains and especially tall buildings.					
	Wood is used for doors and furniture. Sometimes special wood is chosen for its colour, strength or pattern.					
	Plastic is moulded or shaped to form any shape from buckets to animal jelly casts.
