## Year 1 Yellow Spring 2: What Can We Explore in a Garden?

School Value: Self-confidence – we try new things

Topic Sticky Knowledge			
Science	A garden plant is a plant grown especially in a garden. Some common garden plants are roses, daffodils, sunflowers and tulips.		
	A wild plant will grow by itself. It does not need to be cared for like a garden plant. Some common wild plants are daisies, nettles, dandelions and buttercups.		
	Deciduous trees lose their leaves in the autumn every year.  Their leaves are generally broad, flat and have veins running through them.		
	Evergreen trees have green leaves all year round. Their leaves are generally thick, waxy and narrow like needles.		
	Most plants and trees have roots. These are like an anchor that keep plants and trees from blowing over. Sometimes tree roots grow so long that we can see them coming up in pathways and roads!		
Design & Technology	Structures need to be strong and stable. They can be made stronger by choosing sturdy materials and making sure the components are joined securely.		
	The roof or top of an animal feeder can be made waterproof by selecting materials such as cling film or tin foil to cover the top		
	To hold scissors safely, make sure the blades are closed, your hand is around the blade and you always walk when carrying scissors.		
Geography	Maps give us information about places. They tell us where places are and help us to identify where things are located.		
	Aerial photos give us a bird's eye view of our local area and the physical features of Hounslow.

Science	Deciduous	Deciduous is the name given to trees that lose their leaves in autumn and are bare in the winter.		
	Evergreen	Evergreen is the name of trees that have leaves all your round.		
	Wild Plants	A wild plant seed grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows.		
	Leaves	Leaves catch sunlight to make energy.		
	Stem	The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers		
	Flower	Flowers attract insects and birds.

	Symbol	An object or picture that represents something else. Together with a map, your list of symbols makes a key.

RE	Palm Sunday is the day that Jesus arrived in Jerusalem on a donkey. Jesus rode on a donkey as a symbol of peace.		
	The day is called Palm Sunday because people threw palm leaves to the floor for a greeting when Jesus arrived. This was a sign of great respect because they had heard of all the amazing things he had done. They also threw down their clothes.		
	Today Palm Sunday is commemorated by people carrying palm branches or other branches to church. Palm Sunday is always the final Sunday before Easter and the final day of Lent.		
	Christians believe that Jesus died on the cross about 2000 years ago in Jerusalem		
	Christians believe that Jesus died so that everyone can lead a good life		
Music	Bossa Nova music comes from South America. It doesn't matter when you listen to this music if you like it or not, but try and think about the reasons why.		
Computing	When we listen to music from an iPad, the computer or from a website like Spotify, this is music in a digital format.		
	Lots of the music we hear today has been created digitally in music studios, where it is recorded and stored as numbers		
	When music is stored digitally, it can be changed easily to make songs. Examples of this can be repeating parts, layering sounds and using samples.		
	Repetition in music production means that computer programs can contain instructions to repeat sounds a number of times in a song
