Stand-Alone Sticky Knowledge	
RE	Good Friday is part of the Easter story. It was the day that Jesus was crucified on the cross. Good Friday is seen as a very important day in the Christian calendar because Christians believe that Jesus sacrificed himself for others.
	The night before he died, Jesus ate a “Last Supper” with his closest friends (the 12 disciples) where he broke and shared bread and passed a cup of wine.
	Jesus picked up some bread and told the disciples: “This is my body. Take it and eat it and remember me.” He picked up the wine and said: “This is my blood. Drink it and remember me.”
	One of Jesus’ disciples (Judas Iscariot) betrayed Jesus for 30 silver pieces. Jesus knew this at the Last Supper.
	Jewish leaders found Jesus guilty of calling himself the Son of God. Jesus was taken to Pontius Pilate for a punishment. The chief priests convinced the people that Jesus must die. When Pontius Pilate asked what he should do with Jesus, they shouted, “Crucify him!”
	A crown of thorns was put on Jesus’ head. He had to carry his own large wooden cross up a hill. At the top of the hill, Jesus was nailed to the cross, with nails through his hands and feet. Jesus was left on the cross to die.
	Dragon Song tells the story of Lesley the Dragon who flies around the world in search of friendship. When listening, think about the issues of kindness, respect, friendship, acceptance and happiness.
