Topic Sticky Knowledge	
History	When your Parents and Grandparents were little, they played with lots of toys! They didn't have as many devices as we do now. Some things that they played with include: dolls, board games, sports activities, teddies and dressing up. Lots of these things are still played with now!
	Ole Kirk Christiansen invented Lego in 1949. An inventor makes or discovers a new way of doing something. They might make or design something new.
	At playtime, some of the activities that our Parents and Grandparents did are the same as us, like playing sports and running. However, they played a lot more skipping games and games with chalk, like hopscotch.
Geography	Grove Road Primary School looked very different when people the same age as your parents attended. The shared area and classrooms were a different type of building and the playground did not contain any Astro-turf, sandpit or valleys.
	Grove Road School is on Cromwell Road. This is in the town of Hounslow. Hounslow is part of Greater London. Greater London is in the United Kingdom.
	An aerial photograph is a good way of looking at our town – it is a photo taken from high up in the sky looking down.
Science	In the UK we have four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter. Summer is the hottest season and winter the coldest.
	Seasons change throughout the year because of the way the Earth travels around the Sun.

	Village	A small group of houses and possibly some shops, sometimes in the countryside.
	Town	A bigger group of houses and shops where a lot more people live. They usually have a town centre.
Science	City	A big town that royalty have decided is important enough to be a city. Sometimes they have a cathedral too.
	Autumn	From September to November. Many leaves fall from the trees at this time.
D&T	Winter	The coldest season in the UK, between December and February.

RE	The Creation Story is found in the Bible. Christians believe that God created the world in six days, then rested on the seventh day.
	Day 1 – First, God created night and day. Day 2 – God made the seas and the sky. Day 3 – God separated the land and the waters. He made plants and trees. Day 4 – Then God created planets, solar systems and galaxies. Day 5 – Next, God filled the Earth with chirping birds and sea creatures packed the oceans.
	Day 6 – God created all the living creatures on the land. He left the very best for last, humans. God created man and woman in his image. At the end, God said IT WAS VERY GOOD. He gave humans responsibility to look after his creation. Day 7 – God rested. He had had a busy week!
	Christians believe that God wants people to look after the world He has created it for them. This is called being a good steward.
	When you listen to music, you can sometimes clap the pulse. It is a bit like a heartbeat in a song.
	You can make different sounds with your voice and can rap or sing. You can change the pitch with your voice by singing different notes.

	An eBook can include pictures and audio. You don't need to worry about printing it, it is made to be read on a computer or tablet.
