As part of our PSHE and Science policy, Relationships Education lessons are taught through the Jigsaw scheme of work. We have successfully used this scheme for a number of years and has been no change to previous content. Lessons will cover the following objectives:

Year 1 & 2	The difference between boys' and girls' bodies
Year 3	How babies grow, inside and outside body changes
Year 4	Male and female body parts, girls and puberty (periods)
Year 5	Puberty for boys and girls (also covered in Science), conception
Year 6	Puberty for boys and girls, conception to birth, boyfriends & girlfriends

The aims of these lessons are:

- To make children aware of the physical and emotional changes they will experience.
- To give children accurate and acceptable words for all parts of the body.
- To generate an atmosphere where questions can be discussed frankly without embarrassment.
- To help children understand the responsibilities involved in relationships and the value of family life.
- To build confidence and self-esteem to help children value their own safety and make good choices.
