Below are some of the things we are learning this half-term in English & Maths as well as the homework expectations for this term:

English	Maths
<p><u>Grammar, spelling and punctuation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adjectives• Complex sentences• Noun phrases• Prepositions <p><u>Speaking & Listening</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use developing vocabulary to clearly structure my descriptions <p><u>Genre of writing to be covered within topic</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fictional stories• Recounts - Diaries• Historical Narrative• Non-Chronological Reports <p><u>Spelling</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Y3 words and spelling rules <p>We will also be continuing to have Book Talk sessions.</p>	<p><u>Fractions</u></p> <p>We will be exploring and working with fractions. We will begin the chapter by counting in tenths and then understanding fractions as division. We will move on to finding fractions of whole numbers as part of a set and looking at sharing and more than 1. We will explore equivalent fractions and look at simplifying fractions before comparing fractions with different denominators. We will be adding and subtracting fractions.</p> <p><u>Angles</u></p> <p>We will be exploring angles using mathematical vocabulary and investigation. We begin by making and finding angles in shapes, then learn how to name certain angles, specifically right angles, acute angles and obtuse angles. We compare angles to one another and then describe turns using both angles and fractions.</p>
